Observers will have to join IOTA in order to receive grazing occultation predictions on a regular basis. Other privileges of IOTA membership include subscription to <u>Occultation Newsletter</u> and predictions for certain other special occultation events, such as total occultations of faint stars during Lunar eclipses and partial occultations of planets by the Moon. Various special papers will be distributed to members, including a detailed zediacal double star list, and a rewritten updated version of David Dunham's grazing occultation papers.

Annual dues, in U.S. currency, are \$7.00 for residents of Hawaii and North America, and \$9.00 for others, the extra to cover air mail postage. Requests for detailed predictions of grazing occultations, formerly sent to David Dunham, should now be requested from IOTA at the address above. 
